However, I am sure you will all agree we have definitely had some difficulties in the car park this week. Our new suggested timings have clearly not worked and it has become very complicated to safely pick up children from school.

I am sorry for this. Our intention was to limit the time lost in class for the children every week through staggering school times, while also being aware of siblings and the need to stay safe.

So, apologies but I am going to suggest **new** times. I just want to keep everyone safe and I thank those parents who have shared their difficulties with me this week. Afternoons

Willow and Ash and Pre School to be picked up at 3.15pm (and siblings) to be picked up at 3.25pm (and siblings)

Oak to be picked up at 3.35pm

School taxi 3.35pm
